

DISASSEMBLY

Steps may vary depending on trim level and optional equipment.

- 1. Disconnect the wiring harness from the plug below the driver side tail light.
- Use an 18mm socket to remove (4) bolts under the frame rail - (2) at each side. Remove tow hooks (if equipped).
- 3. Use a 13mm socket to remove (2) bolts from the tabs at the outside of the frame (1) per side. Remove the bumper from the vehicle.

ASSEMBLY

- 4. Accent plates should be painted in advance if you choose to do so. Install the logo accent plate using the provided 1/4" hardware (4)A, (4)D, (8)E. Use a 7/16" wrench and a 5/32" hex key to secure.
- The bumper will be installed into the frame rails.Take a moment to wipe away any debris that may interfere with fitment.
- Install the bumper into the frame rails. Slide the bumper to the proper depth where the holes align with the holes in the frame.
- 7. Install the provided 5/8" hardware at each side of the vehicle (1)C, (1)G. Do not fully tighten yet.
- 8. Install the provided 3/8" hardware at each side of the vehicle (1)B, (1)F.
- 9. Use a 15/16 socket to tighten 5/8" bolts. Use a 9/16" socket to tighten the 3/8" bolts.
