

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


DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Remove camera cover. Use a T40 Torx to turn the screw to unlock position. Slide the cover off.
- 2. Remove (3) Lug nuts - 22 mm socket.
- 3. Remove tire from carrier.
- 4. Remove the cover from the 3rd brake light arm - (7) T25 screws.
- 5. Remove the 3rd brake light - (2) T25 screws.
- 6. Unplug 3rd brake light.
- 7. Remove (8) bolts holding the carrier using a 13MM socket.
- 8. Remove (2) T25 screws on carrier from left and right side of camera.
- Remove (3) T8 screws to remove camera 9. from mount.
- 10. Unplug wiring from back of camera.
- 11. Clean the mounting surface.

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ASSEMBLY


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- 12. The logo backing plates can be customized to a color of your choice. If you choose to paint them, please do so in advance and allow proper dry time.
- 13. We recommend wiring the license plate light to the OEM license plate light wiring. You will need additional wiring and you will use the connection method of your choice.
- 14. For a clean wire routing, we recommend running all wiring behind the plastic panel on inside of the tail gate. Use trim removal tools to pry off the panel.
- Locate the sleeve near the tail gate door 15. hinges. Run wiring through the sleeve with the other wires and along the inside of the tail gate towards the handle side.
- 16. Install camera to tramp stamp - (3) screws. (A)
- **17**. Install camera cover - (2) screws (B).
- 18. Install your license plate into the frame and secure with (4) 1/4-20 screws (D), washers (F) and nuts (I).
- Install license plate light to tramp stamp 19. - (2) screws (C) and nuts. (H)
- Connect wiring for license plate light and 20. plug in the rear camera.
- 21. Install the tramp stamp assembly to the vehicle, using (8) bolts (E) and washers (G). Make sure to position the accent plates behind the logos.
- 22. Reinstall any other trim that was removed during installation.
